

SPI INTERNATIONAL TEAM REGULATION

Application

Eligible candidates are, Dentists, Doctors, Scientific Investigators and professional from other fields with a degree related to the SPI (Surgery, Periodontology and Implantology) study areas that fulfil one of the following requisites:

- Be invited by the Board of Directors.
- Submission of the application by 3 members of the SPI International Team and/or by the Board of Editors of JSPIR (Journal of Surgery, Periodontology and Implant Research).
- Spontaneous application through CV appreciation along with at least two recommendation letters from members of the: SPIRC Board of Directors; JSPIR Board of Editors or from distinguished personalities recognized and approved by the JSPIR Board of Editors, along with:
 - At least 500h of certified formation/training in one of the fields of study of SPIRC
 - Fulfil one the following conditions:
 - Submission and presentation of 20 complete clinical cases in the field of action of SPIRC.
 - Having previously published at least 3 articles in the fields of action of SPIRC in indexed journals with impact factor.
 - Having previously published more than 5 scientific papers in the JSPIR.

All applications are dependent on final approval by the Board of Directors.

Application exclusion conditions

All applicants that do not fulfil the minimum requisites stated, or that present untruthful information will be excluded, except by decision of the SPIRC Board of Directors.

Obligations of the SPI International Team

- Presence in the Events and External Seminars organised by the SPI International Team in their country (attending fees are free for members).
- Annual submission of one scientific paper accepted for publication in the JSPIR (non applicable to members that are “Trainers” or that are part of the “Organisation Committee” of the SPIRC Events).

Privileges and Benefits of the SPI International Team

- Free access to the Journal.
- Participation by invitation to be “Speaker”, “Trainer” or member of the “Organisation Committee” in Seminars, Congresses, Symposiums, Courses among other events organised by SPIRC, in person or by videoconference.
- Participation by invitation or self-application to be “Reviewer of the JSPIR” IF the member is considered “Expert” in one of the fields of study of the JSPIR.
- Exclusive discounts in courses organised by SPIRC.
- Support and discussion of clinical cases among the SPI International Team members through an internal platform.
